The KanJam Cup is a handler team only competition.

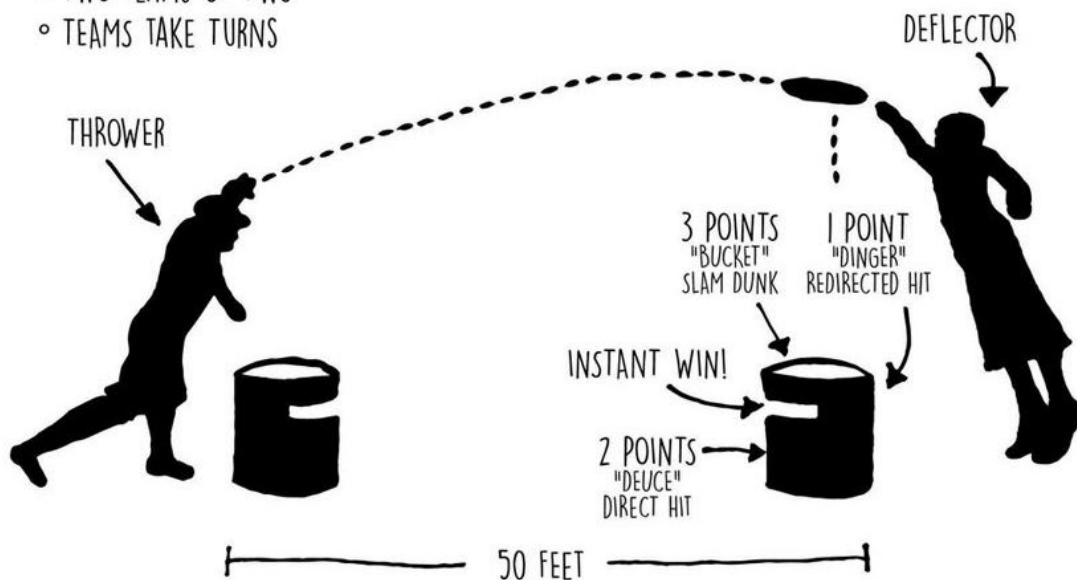
The 2018 KanJam Cup will be a Knockout Competition Format with a Last Chance Round for all teams knocked out in the first round.

CONDITIONS

Competition to be held under the Rules and Regulations of Canine Disc Australia (judging/scoring details for all events will be announced by the judge prior to the Event), and must adhere to the General Ground Rules of the Canine Disc Australia LTD...

All dogs and handlers must be a member with CDA.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry. Any dog who has had contact with an infectious disease (except kennel cough), will be excluded from any CDA event for 18 days post contact. If a dog on club grounds is established as having an infectious disease (except kennel cough), then all dogs on the ground are excluded from CDA events for 18 days.

Any dog who has kennel cough, or is in the same household as a dog known to have Kennel Cough is excluded from any CDA sanctioned event for 21 days from the onset of clinical signs of kennel cough...
